

## SODA KILN POTTERY CLASS



## MONOPRINTING ON CLAY WORKSHOP

This workshop involves the process of image transfer from a plaster slab to a clay slab. Students will create "art" on the plaster slabs using underglazes of all colors. ## WOOD FIRING WORKSHOP

Wood-fired ceramics have a special patina from the deposit of ash and the mark of flame. The earth's oldest known ceramics were fired in wood. Unlike modern reduction firing in gas and electric kilns, this process directly involves the maker. In our mini train style kiln, pieces are high fired to cone 8 in four to five hours. It is a team effort and you will help prepare the wood, stoke the kiln and tend the fire. Your bisque fired and reduction glazed stoneware pieces must be ready to load by Saturday afternoon, and the instructor is available for prep help. Limit six pieces or as space allows.
