Head Start provides a no fee educational experience for 3- and 4-year-old children who meet specific eligibility requirements: low-income, homeless or child with identified special needs. You must be a City of Lakewood resident to participate in the Head Start program. If you live outside of the City of Lakewood, we will assist with resources upon request. Families with special needs are encouraged to apply. In order to be eligible for the current program year, children must be 3 but not yet 5, by October 1, 2013. Head Start classrooms are located in four locations within Lakewood.

Colorado Preschool Program (CPP) provides a no-fee (except for a \$30 nonrefundable enrollment fee) educational experience for 3- and 4-year-old children who are experiencing life circumstances that may interfere with their learning. In order to be eligible for the current program year, children must be 3 but not yet 5, by October 1, 2013. Children must be screened for eligibility. City of Lakewood CPP preschools are located in three locations within Lakewood.
