## **CROWN HILL PARK PROJECT INFORMATION AND SURVEY AVAILABLE**

To address the aging infrastructure of the Park, protect and enhance Park resources and provide additional accommodations for social, recreation and education opportunities for a growing number of visitors, Jefferson County Open Space (JCOS) gathered public input in several different ways and developed a plan to address Park and visitor needs.

Concerns have been raised about these planned projects at the Park. In order to be sure we have heard from a representative cross-section of the community, Jefferson County Open Space is seeking more input from citizens about Crown Hill Park and how it can best serve the needs of our County.

Today, in order to provide opportunity for additional public input, Jefferson County Open Space (JCOS) has compiled additional information on the project and posted the narrative and illustrations on the [Crown Hill Park webpage](#). JCOS consulted with an independent research firm to construct an electronic survey regarding the proposed amenities, and gathered contact information through an email contact list at [crownhill@jeffco.us](mailto:crownhill@jeffco.us) for future Park updates and survey access.

Projects on which JCOS is asking for input are whether a pergola/seasonal shade area is desired or not; whether removed fitness equipment should be replaced and which option is preferred; and if the three proposed Nature Place areas should be constructed. These Nature Place features include an area for digging, climbing and an elevated deck structure titled The Perch.

Those wanting to participate in the survey must register their email address at [crownhill@jeffco.us](mailto:crownhill@jeffco.us) no later than 5:00 p.m. Monday, March 18. Those registered will receive instructions on how to complete the 2013 Crown Hill Park Survey in an email message from *RRC Associates*. **All survey responses must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 21.**

Following the conclusion of the survey, Jefferson County Open Space will hold a public meeting sometime in April at a location near Crown Hill Park. The purpose will be to review survey results and to present to the community the proposed changes at the Park after incorporating the additional citizen input into the planning process. If survey results do not clearly demonstrate overwhelming support or objection to specific amenities, additional input on these items may be sought at this meeting.
