AN ORDINANCE

SETTING THE SALARIES OF MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGES

WHEREAS, Sections 5.6 and 5.8 of the City of Lakewood (the "City") home rule charter (the "Charter") and Section 2.20.050(A) of the Lakewood Municipal Code ("LMC") provide that compensation for Municipal Court Judges shall be established by ordinance;

WHEREAS, the City of Lakewood's Judges Salary Committee has recommended the 2021-2022 annual salaries for the Presiding Judge and the Municipal Judge, as well as the hourly rates for part-time Associate Municipal Judges, as set forth herein;

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to adopt the recommendations of the Judges' Salary Committee and to set the 2022-2023 salaries accordingly; and

WHEREAS, approval of this ordinance on first reading is intended to confirm only that the City Council desires to comply with the Lakewood Municipal Code by setting a public hearing to provide City staff and the public an opportunity to present evidence and testimony regarding the proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lakewood, Colorado, that:

- SECTION 1. The salaries which commenced on March 20, 2020, for Lakewood Municipal Court Judges shall remain as follows:
 - A. The annual salary of the Presiding Municipal Judge shall be One Hundred Eighty-four Thousand and Three Hundred and Five Dollars (\$184,305.00);
 - B. The annual salary of Municipal Judges shall be One Hundred Sixty-four Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-six dollars (\$164,576.00);
 - C. The hourly rate for Regular Part-Time Associate Municipal Judges shall be Sixty and 96/100 dollars (\$60.96); and
 - D. The hourly rate for Variable Part-Time Associate Municipal Judges shall be Eighty-seven and 48/100 dollars (\$87.48).

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after final publication.
