Restrictions

- National Register of Historic Places
 - ✓ Work undertaken through Federal funds or permits must be reviewed for effect on historic property.
 - ✓ No restrictions on other actions.
- State Register of Historic Properties
 - ✓ Work undertaken through State funds must be reviewed for effect on historic property.
 - ✓ No restrictions on other actions.
- Designation by a Certified Local Government
 - ✓ Varies by local preservation ordinance.

Process

 - ✓ Submit Preliminary Evaluation Form
 - ✓ Conduct Research and Take Photographs
 - ✓ Prepare and Submit Nomination to History Colorado
 - ✓ Nomination Reviewed by Colorado Historic Preservation Review Board
 - ✓ Nomination Forwarded to National Park Service for Review and Listing
- State Register of Historic Properties
 - ✓ Submit Preliminary Evaluation Form
 - ✓ Conduct Research and Take Photographs
 - ✓ Prepare and Submit Nomination to History Colorado
 - ✓ Nomination Reviewed by Colorado State Register Review Board
 - ✓ Nomination Forwarded to History Colorado Board of Directors for Review and Listing

 - ✓ Prepare and Submit Nomination to Local Preservation Commission
