Ballmer Peak Distillery - Hand Sanitizer Heroes & Resource Conservation

Ballmer Peak Distillery continues to emphasize zero waste and conservation in its core operations, building upon its water recirculation system and donations of spent grain and molasses to regenerative agriculture. In spring of 2020, Ballmer Peak was quick to notice the lack of available hand sanitizer when the COVID-19 pandemic arrived in Colorado. Ballmer Peak swiftly adapted its business to produce hand sanitizer and became one of the first distilleries in Colorado to

produce free hand sanitizer for the community. Ballmer Peak is also partnering with other brewers to convert waste alcoholic beverages into hand sanitizer and into new beverages to be sold in their tasting room. The innovative conservation strategies and thoughtful public health initiatives at Ballmer Peak earn the business its second Lakewood Sustainability Award.
