Greg Foreman and Mollie Fendley have created beautiful, pollinator friendly, and water wise landscapes across the City. Their creative and sustainable landscapes can be seen in the City's medians, parks, golf courses, and regional parks. Besides making Lakewood a beautiful place to live, Greg and Mollie's gardens are living classrooms engaging anyone interested in learning how to create sustainable landscapes.

Mollie and Greg helped Fox Hollow Golf Course convert their clubhouse landscape beds into low water-use perennial beds, leant their expertise to the Bear Creek Lake Park Visitor Center to creating a butterfly and hummingbird garden, and residents and visitors to Lakewood can view one of the best Xeriscape gardens in the metro area thanks to their work at Kendrick Lakes Park. The Kendrick Lakes Park Xeriscape garden includes five beds representing various plant communities from the plains to the alpine.
