Clients at the **Green Mountain Recreation Center** did not appear to notice that something was different this past winter, which was exactly what Sara Livingston and Kerry Clannin were hoping would happen. In mid-December 2012, the center replaced supplies with more sustainable and environmentally friendly products including typical personal hygiene products such as foam hand soap, hand sanitizer, and body wash; cleaning products such as glass cleaner and disinfectant; and paper products including paper towels and toilet paper.

The project, led by staff from the City's Purchasing Division, Green Mountain Recreation Center, and Community Resources Department, has been highly successful and is now being rolled out to the other three City recreation centers. All of the products cost less while providing a less toxic environment for resident and employees.
