Clients at the **Green Mountain Recreation Center** did not appear to notice that something was different this past winter, which was exactly what Sara Livingston and Kerry Clannin were hoping would happen. In mid-December 2012, the center replaced supplies with more sustainable and environmentally friendly products including typical personal hygiene products such as foam hand soap, hand sanitizer, and body wash; cleaning products such as glass cleaner and disinfectant; and paper products including paper towels and toilet paper.

The project, led by staff from the **City's Purchasing Division, Green Mountain Recreation Center, and Community Resources Department**, has been highly successful and is now being rolled out to the other three City recreation centers. All of the products cost less while providing a less toxic environment for resident and employees.
