✓ Waste Reduction and Recycling

Goodwill Industries of Denver is one of the largest recyclers in the state of Colorado. Last year, the store on Wadsworth and Florida collected 2 million pounds of clothing, housewares, sporting goods, electronics and computers, keeping them out of landfills. Companywide, they kept nearly 30 million pounds out of the landfill, thus avoiding 6,400 tons of CO2.

Being sustainable is also more than being environmentally friendly. It is also about sustaining communities. Goodwill is able to do so by supporting a growing economy through a model that provides education, training, and programs for the disabled and working poor to attain self-sufficiency.
