The Denver Federal Center is a 640 acre federal facility operated by the General Services Administration. There are approximately 50 buildings at the Federal Center. GSA's goal is to make this facility the most sustainable business park in the country and actively employs sustainable management practices.

Power produced during sunny parts of the day from the solar array reduces the Federal Center's peak power demand by 10%, reducing reliance on fossil fuels to power the site. The annual expected reduction in emissions is equivalent to removing 228 cars from the highway per year.
