St. Anthony Medical Campus in Lakewood includes two medical plazas designed and constructed to include significant sustainable design elements. In addition to environmentally friendly design, the buildings contribute to community sustainability through waste reduction and recycling programs and by engaging Lakewood residents in health and wellness programs.

Innovative sustainable design elements include:

- Light roof colors to reduce heat gain.
- Energy efficient air conditioning units, perimeter insulation, and high performance windows.
- Use of locally manufactured materials including masonry brick
- Use of low-emitting adhesives, sealants, paints, and carpets to protect indoor air quality.
- Controlled lighting systems
- Design integrated access to the RTD Park & Ride and Light Rail Station
