## 2017 DEFENDER OF THE PLANET YOUTH AWARD Water Conservation & Cleanup Green Mountain Area Homeschoolers





The Green Mountain Area Homeschoolers combined curiosity and personal initiative to address water conservation and clean up waterways in Lakewood. The students began their project by touring a local water treatment plant; watching the documentary "The Great Divide" about Colorado water history and issues; learning about watershed monitoring; and interviewing Lakewood City staff and elected officials. Using funding from the Jane Goodall Institute, the students planted willows along Bear Creek to prevent erosion, picked up trash along the riparian corridor and distributed native, low-water seeds to residents.
